CONWAY SCHOOL DISTRICT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM FORM

The Conway School Board has adopted a plan for Conway residents to select the elementary school they want their children to attend. The plan has the following restrictions:

- Parents/guardians who live in the school's attendance zone have first priority. If a choice is not made, the child will attend the school serving the area in which the family lives.
- ➤ Parents/guardians will be responsible for transportation to schools outside of the attendance zone; however, if bus transportation is available without altering routes, and space is available, the students may ride the bus.
- Transfers must be cost neutral. (If a child requires a special program offered at the assigned school, which is not offered at the requested school, the transfer may be denied.)
- > Transfer of a child in a special education program requires approval of the placement team.
- > Selection of a school outside of the normal attendance zone will be for the entire school year unless circumstances cause revocation by the Superintendent.

Parents/guardians are invited to exercise a choice in schools at their discretion. Complete the following and

- > Transfer to a school outside of the attendance zone will be on a space available basis. Space available is defined as fewer than 20 students enrolled in a class. Once a transfer is approved, the child may remain in that school throughout the elementary years.
- ➤ Priority will be given to siblings of students currently enrolled.
