

**BARTLETT SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the Inhabitants of the School District of Bartlett, in the County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote on District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Josiah Bartlett Elementary School gymnasium in said District on Tuesday, March 16, 2010 at 6:30 in the evening to act upon the following subjects:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of seven million, six hundred fifty-nine thousand, two hundred and forty-seven dollars (\$7,659,247) for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for school district officials and agents, and for the payment of statutory obligations of the District. This article does not include appropriations voted in other warrant articles. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 4-0-0)

ARTICLE 2: To see if the School District will vote to approve the cost item included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Bartlett School Board and the Bartlett Education Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

<u>Year</u>	<u>Estimated Increase</u>
2010-11	\$ 0 (Note – estimated Evergreen legislation increased budget \$90,613)
2011-12	\$9,738 (Note – estimated Evergreen legislation increased budget \$91,582)

and further to raise and appropriate the sum of zero dollars (\$0) for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels under the existing collective bargaining agreement.

(Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

Note: Pursuant to RSA 273-A:12, if approved, the terms of this collective bargaining agreement, including the pay plan, but excluding cost of living increases, will continue in force and effect until a new agreement is executed.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) to initiate the next phase of the Technology Program as recommended by the Technology Committee. (Designated as a Special Article) (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 4: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of thirty-eight thousand, five hundred dollars (\$38,500) to replace the roof above the cafeteria and authorize the withdrawal of thirty-eight thousand, five hundred dollars (\$38,500) from the Capital Reserve Fund (Maintenance) created for that purpose. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 5: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of ninety-four thousand five hundred dollars (\$94,500) to purchase a new school bus and authorize the withdrawal of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) from the capital reserve fund created for that purpose. The balance of sixty-four thousand five hundred dollars (\$64,500) is to come from general taxation. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 6: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of thirty-two thousand, eight hundred and thirty-three dollars (\$32,833) for the purpose of addressing fire safety codes. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 4-0-0)

ARTICLE 7: To see if the School District will vote to approve the three-year tuition contract with the Hart's Location School District for their K-8 students to attend the Josiah Bartlett Elementary School. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 8: To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
