

**CHATHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the Inhabitants of the School District of Chatham, in the County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote on District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet in the Town Hall in said District on Tuesday, the 9th day of March, 2010 to act upon the following subjects. The meeting will take place at 6:30 p.m.

ARTICLE 1. To elect a Clerk for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 2. To elect a member of the School Board for the ensuing three years.

ARTICLE 3. To elect a Treasurer for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 4. To elect an Auditor for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 5. To elect a Moderator for the ensuing two years.

ARTICLE 6. To see what sum the School District will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for school district officials and agents, and for the payment of the statutory obligations of the District. The Budget Committee recommends \$709,006 (5-0-0). The School Board recommends \$709,006 (2-0-0). This article does not include appropriations voted in other warrant articles. (Majority vote required)

ARTICLE 7. To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate \$5,000 to be placed in the Capital Reserve Fund (Special Education) previously established for this purpose. (Recommended by the School Board 2-0-0) (Recommended by the Budget Committee 4-1-0)

ARTICLE 8. To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate up to \$5,000 to be placed in the Expendable Trust Fund (Tuition Trust Fund) previously established for this purpose, with such amount to be funded from the year end undesignated fund balance available on July 1, 2010. (Recommended by the School Board 2-0-0) (Recommended by the Budget Committee 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 9. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
