

**RECREATIONAL USE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY**

In recognizing its responsibility to provide, wherever possible consistent with school needs, recreational facilities for the Town, the Bartlett School Board wishes to express its intent with regard to a certain area beginning at a point where the east side of Albany Avenue intersects the Maine Central Railroad (M.C.R.R.) crossing right of way thence running North 95' parallel to Albany Avenue where it is joined by Railroad Street, thence 350' East parallel to Railroad Street to the Catholic Church parking lot, thence South 95' to the M.C.R.R. right of way, thence 350' West parallel to M.C.R.R. right of way, to the point of beginning. Containing 0.75 acre, more or less.

It is the policy and intent of the Bartlett School Board to hold the aforesaid area for use as a park and recreation area by the residents and students of the Town of Bartlett.

It is further the policy of the Bartlett School Board to cooperate with the Bartlett Selectmen in establishing rules and regulations for such recreational use when and if that becomes necessary.
