

TUITION POLICY
FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING FROM NON-CONTRACT TOWNS
(including private tuition students)

Under current contracts, tuition charges for the various towns are based on a combination of equalized value and/or ADM. Each year a tuition fee is charged to each town.

For students attending from non-contract towns the tuition shall be determined as follows:

1. Using the latest tuition fee for each *contracted* town, each town's total tuition fee will be divided by that town's ADM-R. This will determine the "cost per student" for each town.
2. The *contracted* town with the highest "cost per student" shall be used as the tuition charge for non-contract students.

Tuition for non-contracted students shall be pro-rated based on date of enrollment and/or withdrawal. The full annual tuition charges shall be due no later than the first day of enrollment. Failure to pay within 10 days of enrollment will automatically result in the student being withdrawn from school. In the case of withdrawal, the receiving district shall reimburse prior payments on a prorated basis.

If a student requires special accommodations/services additional costs may be charged accordingly.
