RESIGNATION OF PROFESSIONAL STAFF MEMBER

The School Board is responsible for the employment of a professional staff that will help educate students in as effective a manner as is possible.

The Board recognizes that extenuating circumstances may arise during a school year necessitating special consideration of a resignation, and will review each such case on its individual merits in accordance with procedures attached.

Procedure

From Article 28-4.1 of CEA Contract

Any teacher wishing to resign shall give 30 days written notice to the Chairperson of the School Board and the Superintendent. Any teacher not providing a 30 day notice of resignation shall have the sum of \$200 deducted from their final pay.
