**LEA RESPONSIBILITIES FOR NON-CONWAY SPECIAL  
EDUCATION STUDENTS**

Conway educational employees will assume responsibility for achieving consensus from the IEP Team for educational programming decisions for students from other districts attending Conway schools. The sending town will assume financial liability for the educational decisions made by the IEP Team. The principal of the Conway school or his/her designee will serve as the LEA for the IEP meeting. The Special Education Director from the sending town will be invited to participate in the IEP meeting and shall have equal input.

The input of any representative of the sending district, as well as that of the SAU #9 special education representative, will be considered by the Team. If consensus on IEP issues cannot be reached, the Team will reconvene at the earliest possible date to review the issues. If the Team cannot reach consensus at that time, the Superintendent(s) of both sending and receiving towns will be notified to assist in resolution of the issue(s).

The SAU #9 Special Services Director will be advised of any financial obligations as a result of the IEP meeting.
