

**Home School Student Fair and Equitable Placement upon Enrollment
at Kennett High School**

Prior to a home school student being enrolled at Kennett High School, the student must submit documentation on his/her academic accomplishments in the home school setting. This documentation will be reviewed by the Guidance Director who will determine credit equivalents. The Guidance Director will present his/her determination to the home schooled student's family in writing.

For the purposes of class placement and meeting Kennett High School graduation requirements, credit equivalents will be used synonymously with credits issued by an accredited high school. That is, if it is determined a home school student has credit equivalents for two English courses, he/she would need an additional two English classes to meet high school graduation requirements.

Home school accomplishments will be listed on the student's Kennett High School transcript, but it will be clearly noted that the work was completed in a home school setting. There will be no designation for level, grade, or credit on the transcript.

To be eligible to earn a Kennett High School diploma, home school students must earn a minimum of 50% plus one of the total credits required for graduation from Kennett High School or another accredited school.

The issue of class rank for former home school students is addressed in Policy IKC.
