HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT FOR EIGHTH GRADE STUDENTS

Approval Standard Ed 306.26 (e) reads: The local school board may develop a policy that grants credits to students taking coursework in the seventh or eighth grade toward high school graduation, if the course demonstrates content requirements consistent with related high school course(s) and the student achieves passing grades.

The School Board allows high school credits to be granted for Algebra I and/or for French/Spanish/German I providing the grade 8 student passes the high school Summative Assessment for Algebra I and/or French/Spanish/German I at the level of competency required of a grade 9 student to have the credit granted.

Procedure

The summative assessment will be given at the conclusion of the Grade 8 course.
