

MAXIMUM AGE FOR ATTENDANCE

(1) A person who has attained the age of twenty years on or before the opening of the school year shall not be enrolled in any regular senior high school program, provided that an enrolled student who is involved in a continuous study program shall be exempt from this restriction. A student is deemed in a continuous high school program even though such program is interrupted by illness.

(2) A student who is officially designated with an educational hardship (special education) shall be considered “in a continuous program” when the student’s IEP requires continued service by the school system until age 21.

(3) At no time will a person’s continuous study program be extended beyond the end of the semester in which the student turns 21 years of age.

(4) Any exception to these limitations shall be made by the superintendent upon recommendation of the principal, and special education staff if appropriate.
