

TUITION STUDENTS

-- Tuition Students Normally Eligible to Attend Conway Schools

Students normally eligible to attend Conway schools are those who reside within the district or one of the sending districts under the AREA Agreement. Generally, the residence of an unemancipated minor whose legal custody rests with a parent/guardian is deemed to reside with that parent/guardian. A nonresident may apply to the School Board for admission, but that application must be filed immediately upon any change of circumstances affecting residence or at the time of registration, if a new student. The Superintendent shall have the authority to permit students to attend pending full review by the Board of such application.

JOINT CUSTODY

The Conway School District recognizes that the guardianship of children may change while that student is in attendance or entering school for the first time.

In order to comply with State and Federal law, and at the same time be able to serve parents and legal guardians appropriately, the Conway School District requires that any lawful change in the guardianship of a student will require submission of legal documentation.
