

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING  
JACKSON SCHOOL BOARD  
Whitney Community Center  
July 7, 2010**

1. **Call to Order:** The July special meeting of the Jackson School Board was called to order by Vice Chair, Keith Bradley, at 5:30 p.m. Also present were Lauren Synnott, Genn Anzaldi, Dr. Carl Nelson and Gayle Dembowski.
  
2. **Approve Minutes (6-8-10):** Dr. Nelson offered the following correction to Pg. 1, Minutes of Public Hearing, 1<sup>st</sup> sentence should read: “...*expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$42,860 from the maintenance trust funds...*” **Motion was made by Ms Anzaldi, seconded by Ms. Synnott, to approve the Minutes of the June 8th meeting as corrected. Motion carried by unanimous vote.**
  
3. **Consider Personnel Actions:**
  - A. **Accept Resignation of Mary Dresser – Motion by Ms. Synnott, second by Ms. Anzaldi, that the Board accept with regret the resignation of Mary Dresser as music teacher. Motion carried by unanimous vote.**
  
  - B. **Election of Summer Personnel – Motion by Ms. Synnott, second by Ms. Anzaldi, to approve election of summer recreation personnel as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote.** [Amanda Bacon, Kathleen Downing, Jennifer Douin, Dexter Harding, Sonya Porter, Margot Robert]
  
  - C. **Election of Mark Davidson as Custodian – Motion by Ms. Synnott, second by Ms. Anzaldi, to elect Mark Davidson as custodian effective July 1, 2010. Motion carried by unanimous vote.**
  
  - D. **Election of Meredith Piotrow as Library Media Specialist – Motion by Ms. Anzaldi, second by Ms. Synnott, that the Board approve election of Meredith Piotrow as Library Media Specialist effective August 30, 2010.** Ms. Anzaldi questioned certification. Ms. Dembowski stated Ms. Piotrow presently has a Statement of Eligibility from DOE, and is going to Plymouth State University to get her Masters degree in Library Science. Ms. Dembowski proposes using Janice Mudgett as mentor for another year.

Upon question of hours, Ms. Dembowski stated Ms. Piotrow has been working five days a week as Special Education Aide and will be working one day as Media Specialist. She will be doing both jobs, but needs that one day. Her current position as Special Ed Aide will be reduced from 30 hours per week to 24 in order to accept the Library Media Specialist position, and Ms. Dembowski intends to propose at the next regular meeting that those hours be given to Melissa Grady.

- E. Consider Election of Sarah Rowe as Part-time Art Teacher – Motion by Ms. Synnott, second by Ms. Anzaldi, that the Board approve election of Sarah Rowe as part-time Art Teacher for the 2010-11 school year. Motion carried by unanimous vote.**
- 4. Any Other Business: Motion was made by Ms. Synnott, seconded by Ms. Anzaldi and carried by unanimous roll call vote, that the Board adjourn to non public session under RSA 91-A:3, II.**
- 5. Non Public Session:** The Board convened non public session at 5:40 p.m.

**Ms. Synnott moved to return to Public Session and adjourn. The motion was seconded by Ms. Anzaldi and passed unanimously at 6:44 p.m.**
