

AGE OF ENTRANCE

A pupil must enter grade one if his/her chronological age will be six before September 30th of the year of entering school.

A pupil may enter kindergarten if his/her chronological age will be five before September 30th of the year of entering school.

A birth certificate must be presented upon registration as proof of the date of birth.

Incoming transfer students in grades 2-6, inclusive, will be initially placed in accordance with the data forwarded by the sending district. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee.

Transfer students in grades K + 1 who do not meet the minimum age requirements will be accepted only if they have been successfully participating in an accredited public school program. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent of Schools.
