## PUBLIC HEARING on 2024-25 Proposed Budget

Superintendent Kevin Richard reviewed the articles on the school warrant beginning with the operating budget. The overall budget is down approximately 20% over the previous year. This reduction is mainly due to the drop in enrolled students in the Conway Schools. The Kennett High School and Middle school bond payments are done as well.

Sara Young Knox asked about homeschooled students and is there accountability for those students. Kevin responded that there is little accountability for students who are homeschooled. The State of NH does not require any oversight or for the family to report to the local school district.

Tim Sorgi asked about the transportation costs being higher than he expected. Kevin explained that the bus contract with Eldridge transportation does not include the Passaconaway Road portion of Albany. There is an agreement with Conway to pick up those students at a cost of approximately \$4,200.

Tim Sorgi read the remaining warrant articles to the public.
